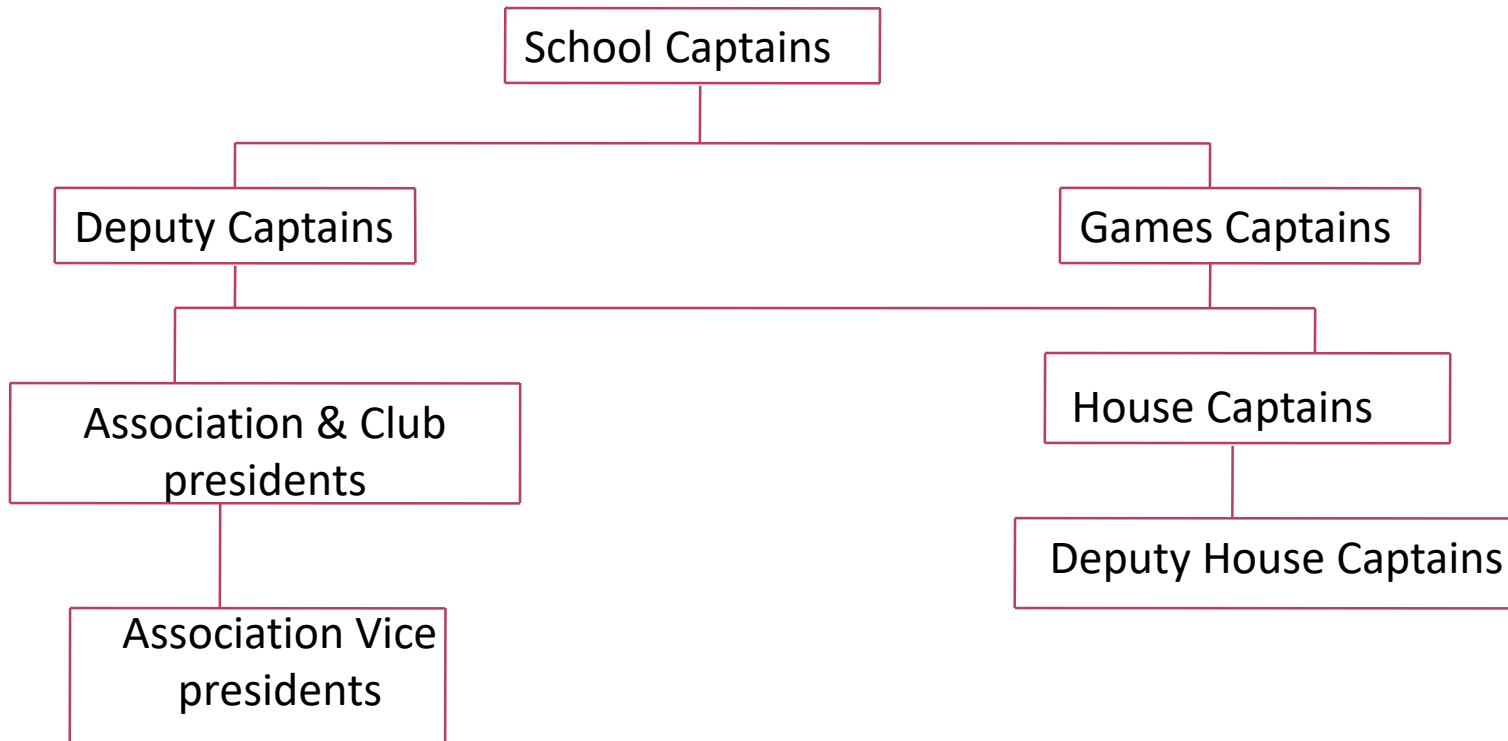
Grade	Post

# REVISED CRITERIA FOR POST APPLICATION ONLY FOR 2016

- Students who apply to the various posts should be eligible according to the following:

School Captain/Deputy Captain	74.5%	64.5%	
House Captain/Deputy Captain	64.5%	64.5%

# POST APPLICATION

- ❑ Each student is required to apply to any **two** positions.
- ❑ The students who got average 75% and above in the final term of 2016 is given the chance to apply to any **two** of the posts
- ❑ Students should apply for the posts by filling an online form which will be available from the School website from **5th February 2017 onwards**

- ❑ **Deadline to apply for the posts: before 1500hrs on 8<sup>th</sup> February 2017**
- ❑ **Necessary documents should be submitted to the school counter before the deadline**

# CRITERIA FOR HOUSE CAPTAINS/ DEPUTY

## DISCIPLINE 10%

- 25 marks are given for this category. Marks would be deducted if any disciplinary problems are recorded . The following shows how marks are deducted
  - If the student has any disciplinary problems which has occurred during last 2 years and the teacher has advised (5 marks )
  - If any disciplinary problems recorded twice within the last year(8 marks)
  - If any disciplinary problems recorded by the ACCOR within the last year (10 marks )
  - If any disciplinary problems which has recorded twice by the ACCOR and advised(15 marks)
  - If any disciplinary problems recorded thrice by the ACCOR and advised(25 marks)

- **Captains and Deputy Captains**: Those students who scored **75%** and above from the above criteria will be nominated for voting
- **Voting** : Students from Grade 4 -10
- **House Captains, Deputy House Captains & Sports Captains**: Those students who scored **65%** and above from the above criteria will be nominated for voting
- **Voting for house posts**: Students from the respective houses will be voting for the posts
- **Voting for Presidents & Vice presidents :** Students from Grade 4 -10 will be voting for the posts

# CLASS REPRESENTATIVES

## ASSOCIATIONS (FILAA, SLATE , FASHALA)

- For each activity we will be selecting **two representatives** from each class above Grade 4.
- Representatives will be selected accordingly to the students interest and choice
- **FILAA**: student who had 75% and above in DHIVEHI last year with an average above 65%
- **SLATE**: student who had 75% and above in ENGLISH with an average of 65% and above
- **FASHALA**: student who had 75% in SOCIAL STUDIES with an average of 65% and above

# CLASS REPRESENTATIVES

## CLUBS

- For each activity we will be selecting **two representatives** from each class above Grade 4
- Representatives will be selected accordingly to the students interest and choice
  - **Science Club**: Student who had scored 75% and above in Science with an average of 65% and above
  - **Math Club** : Student who had scored 75% in Math with an average of 65% and above
  - **Art Club**: Student who has keen interest in Art with an average of 65% and above

# VOTING PROCEDURE

- Interview for School Posts will be held from 9th February onwards
- Candidates list will be up on the web portal and will be announced on the **15<sup>th</sup> February 2016 (Sunday)** assembly
- Campaign
  - Campaign should start after announcing the candidates who are competing
  - Candidates for the senior posts will be given to speak in the special assembly for 2 minutes
  - Materials for campaign
    - Banner (**portrait**) size: not bigger than 2'X 4' feet(1 per each candidate)
    - Poster A 4 size (maximum 10 posters for each floor)
    - Stickers
    - Badge and logo
    - All the materials should be removed by **21<sup>st</sup> February 2017 (Thursday) before 1800hrs**
    - **Any material other than the above is strictly prohibited**

# POSTS ELECTION

- Election will be held on Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2017 starting from 0800hrs in the hall which will be transparent
- **Observers**
  - Candidates can have observers (observer should not be a parent of the candidate)
  - Election will be conducted by a committee from the SMT and school board
  - **Voting slips**
  - Students should tick(✓)near the candidates where he/she vote for
  - **Tie-break**
  - If two students had equal number of votes student will be elected by the highest number of points from the interview
  - **School posts will be announced on the same day**
