Important notes:

1. All text books should be neatly labelled with student's name, index number and class and covered with cellophane only.

These books should also be labelled with student's name, index number and class and covered with cellophane. In case students require covering the books with paper (preferably with plain or simple designed) before covering it with cellophane, they may do so but it is not necessary.
3. It is recommended for students to keep two exercise books for subjects like English, Math and Dhivehi. Otherwise one exercise book will be enough for other subjects.
