



PARENT INVOLVEMENT POLICY

Ghiyasuddin International School (GIS) and the parents of the students participating in activities, services, and programmes of Ghiyasuddin International School agree that the following responsibilities are drawn to improve student's academic achievement. Also, by which the school and parents will build and develop a partnership that will help children achieve the school's standards. This parent involvement policy will be in effect during the 2015 school year.

The parent involvement policy has been introduced to ensure that all parties are aware of their responsibilities. The responsibilities stipulated in the policy will also be a reference for dispute resolution. GIS will uphold the agreement stipulated in the policy; similarly, parent is encouraged to read the policy carefully and ratify it only after all queries have been addressed by the school.

Along with this policy, there is a school-parent contract which should be signed and submitted before the child is enrolled in the school (the contract will be given to existing parents before the end of this academic year). In the case of Grades 1 – 5, the parent and the school will sign the contract. Where as in the case of Grade 6 and above, the child, the parent and the school will sign the contract

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITY of the SCHOOL, the STUDENT and the PARENT

Ghiyasuddin International school students will:

- show respect for all the members of the school community.
- follow all school rules and procedures.
- respect the property of the school and others.
- not bully or intimidate their peers.
- use appropriate language at all times.
- remain in assigned areas unless given permission and can leave only with the "EXIT CARD" or approval from teachers or the management.
- respect the personal space of others, keeping their hands and feet to themselves.
- not bring personal items to school (E.g. Cameras' mobile Phones ...etc) unless school authorizes to bring such items on a special occasion or function.

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- resolve problems and issues while treating everyone with dignity, courtesy, and respect and seek adults help when needed.
- attend school regularly, arrive on time, bring supplies, and be prepared for the day's lessons.
- succeed in school by working to the best of one's ability.
- follow discipline guideline adopted by the school, and class.
- ask for help when in need of assistance.
- act in a courteous and responsible manner in all school-related activities.
- be a participating learner.
- attend all extra, remedial, enrichment and support classes.
- inform parents any information school disseminate regarding student's academic, discipline and activities.
- refrain from unlawful activities in school or out of school.

Ghiyasuddin International school will:

- communicate an expectation for the student to achieve in every class.
- academically mould the students to become upright citizens to function in.
- provide learning for all students in an equitable manner.
- establish and maintain an environment where all may learn.
- recognize and work with all students who have different learning styles.
- respect the rights and confidentiality of students and parents.
- inform and consult parents in assessing the needs and progress of students.
- be proactive toward resolving issues.
- teach all students to be personally responsible.
- act in a courteous and responsible manner in all school-related activities.
- be fair, equitable, and consistent in all interactions.
- be responsive to all students' needs.
- implement approved and accepted teaching and assessment practices.
- initiate parent contact/support at the earliest occurrence of academic or behaviour concerns.
- treat parents and students professionally and respectfully.

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Ghiyasuddin International school parent will:

- accept all the costs incurred in the usual course of the education by the School of your child, including the provision of any necessary educational materials.
- accept that any extra-curricular activities such as sports clubs, private music lessons, trips and visits in which you agree your child may participate shall be deemed to be supplemental to the course of education provided and will be charged for accordingly.
- undertake to ensure that your child complies with the school rules which may be amended from time to time.
- undertake to ensure that your child will attend school punctually and that your child conforms to rules of school discipline policy, practice of learning, uniform codes, grooming and appearance issued by the school from time to time.
- cooperate with school by
 - encouraging your child in his or her studies.
 - giving appropriate support at home.
 - keeping the School informed of matters which affect your child.
 - maintaining a courteous and constructive relationship with School staff.
 - providing co-operation and assistance to the School to ensure that your child can participate and benefit from the School's provision of education to your child.
 - attending meetings otherwise keeping in touch with the School.
 - attending parent-teacher conferences and the meetings requested by the school management.
- agree that the school can question concerned student or any student who may have relevant information when investigating the issues if the school feels certain actions and behaviours are not acceptable or that can be a negative influence for the other students (inquiries will be age appropriate).
- agree that the school can take statement(s) from students (while investigating certain issues) for the use of school's information.
